Trophies and prizes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trophies and awards will be presented to Champion Team, 2nd Place and 3rd Place. • Awards will be presented to MVP and Top Scorer.
Entry Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian \$400 per team HST included. • Includes 2 free closing dinner tickets on June 24th, 2017.
Payment Method	<p>To be eligible, an entry fee (cheque payable to All Community Games) must be accompanied with the registration form.</p> <p>Online payment is also available at http://acgames.ca/soccer</p> <p>ALL registrations are non-refundable and non-transferable unless tournament cancellation.</p>
Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of players limit per team is 20 players maximum (minimum is 12). • If less than 9 players are able to play at the starting time (when the referee calls start), it will be 0-1 lost automatically. • If the team forfeits the game, then all the games with the forfeited team will be changed to 1-0 win. • Preliminary Round games are 25 min halves with two referees. • Preliminary Round Points are; Win 3 points, Tie 1 point and Lose 0 point.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If there are 12 teams participating in the tournament the teams are divided into 3 groups. • Top 2 teams from each group automatically go to the "Tournament Round". • There will be 2 teams from Wild card which is the 7th place and the 8th place throughout the groups in terms of points. • If the points is tied then teams who has the highest "Goal Difference" qualifies. • If the "Goal Difference" is tied then teams who has the highest "Goals For" qualifies. • If it still ties again then it will be decided by "Coin toss". • If the number of participating teams is less than 12, each team will play 3 preliminary games against randomly drawn opponents. The top 8 teams will go to the Tournament Round. • If the number of participating teams is an odd number, one randomly drawn team will play only 2 preliminary games with one automatic 1-0 win. • If the number of participating teams is equal to 8, the tournament will be held in one day only on June 10 and will be played in a 3 games guaranteed format. • Tournament Round will be 30min halves with 3 referees, if tied golden goal 5 min half, if still tied PK-sudden death. Final game PK- • Red card will be fined \$200 to the team with the minimum suspension of 2 games up to 5 games (will be decided by the referees) applies to the player. • 2 yellow cards in same game is equal to a red card, will be suspended the next game only (no charge of fine applied). • Player with 2 yellow cards accumulated in different games will be suspended the next game only (no charge of fine applied). • Rain-Out game will have to be rescheduled by both team's team leaders with their own arrangement.
